There are two Z-Lots on Brink Street (behind The Clothes Gallery) and another Z-Lot at the southwest corner of Grant & Brink. The parking lot at the northeast corner of Main Street and Crystal Lake Avenue is marked as a 4-hour public parking lot, but Z-Lot permit holders are also able to

display their permits and use this parking lot. This is an excellent area for overflow parking. North of the tracks:

The parking lot located immediately to the rear of the former City Hall on Beardsley Street is a shared Public and Z-Lot parking lot. Allotted Z-Lot spaces are located throughout the parking lot, excluding the numbered commuter parking spaces in the two rows on the east side of the parking lot.
